NEW FEES FOR MEMORIAL BENCH PROGRAM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Lancaster will conduct a Public Hearing to consider the adoption of new fees for the newly established Memorial Bench Program. This new program will allow residents to honor a loved one's memory with a personalized bench to be placed at one of our beautiful parks.

The new fee structure for the Memorial Bench Program reflects the costs of purchasing, installing, and maintaining a personalized bench for a 10-year period. The fees will allow for benches purchased to be maintained in ways including, but not limited to, graffiti removal, paint touch up if necessary, and periodic cleaning. These fees have been determined based on the cost of the bench, installation, and standard maintenance for a 10-year period. We also gathered information from other cities and entities who have a similar program and have determined that our fee assessment is fair in comparison.

All persons having information relevant to the proposed resolution are hereby invited to appear at the time and place stated above to present such information to the City Council; or, prior to the hearing, any written correspondence may be submitted to the City Clerk at 44933 North Fern Avenue, Lancaster California, 93534, or by calling the City Clerk's Department at (661) 723-6020 with comments relative to this public hearing.
