Subject: Vacation of the Public Road Easement as Shown on Tract Map No. 35738, and Drainage and Sewer Easements reserved in Instrument Number 5613 of Official Records May 26, 1962, over Aldenvale Avenue

Recommendation:

Adopt **Resolution No. 22-55**, ordering the vacation of a public Road Easement as dedicated on Tract Map No. 35738, and Drainage and Sewer Easements reserved in Instrument Number 5613 of Official Records May 25, 1962, over Aldenvale Avenue located on the south side of Avenue I and approximately 465 feet east of the centerline of 20th Street West.

Fiscal Impact:

None.

Background:

Aldenvale Avenue was first dedicated by Tract 21423 M.B. 636 pages 79-80 in 1958 then vacated, reserving easements for sewer and drainage, by Instrument No. 5613 of Official Records (OR) recorded May 25, 1962. Aldenvale Avenue was then dedicated by Tract 35738 M.B 933 pages 5-7 in 1979. Improvements for the 60-foot-long street were started but never finished, and the street was never open for travel.

On July 30, 2021, Community Development Division Staff recommended Conditions of Approval for Site Plan Review No. 20-04. The condition requires the vacation of Aldenvale Avenue to accommodate the construction of a proposed storm water basin.

On September 13, 2022, the City adopted Resolution No. 22-50, declaring its intention to vacate the subject road easement and set October 11, 2022, as the date of the public hearing to receive testimony relative to the proposed vacation.

The public hearing will be held for the City Council to determine if there are any public objections to the City vacating the road, sewer and drainage easements at Aldenvale Avenue.
